HOW TO USE THIS DIRECTORY:

The format of this year's DIRECTORY is basically the same as in the past. Addresses and other information about each member appears in the regional listings. To find out what region a particular member is in, there is also an alphabetical listing in the front of this DIRECTORY. To look for members close to you, simply look through your own regional listing. The territory covered by each region is shown on the region map. The information presented here is taken directly from your membership application form. If there is a mistake in your listing, please contact the Secretary for changes.

A typical listing might be as follows:

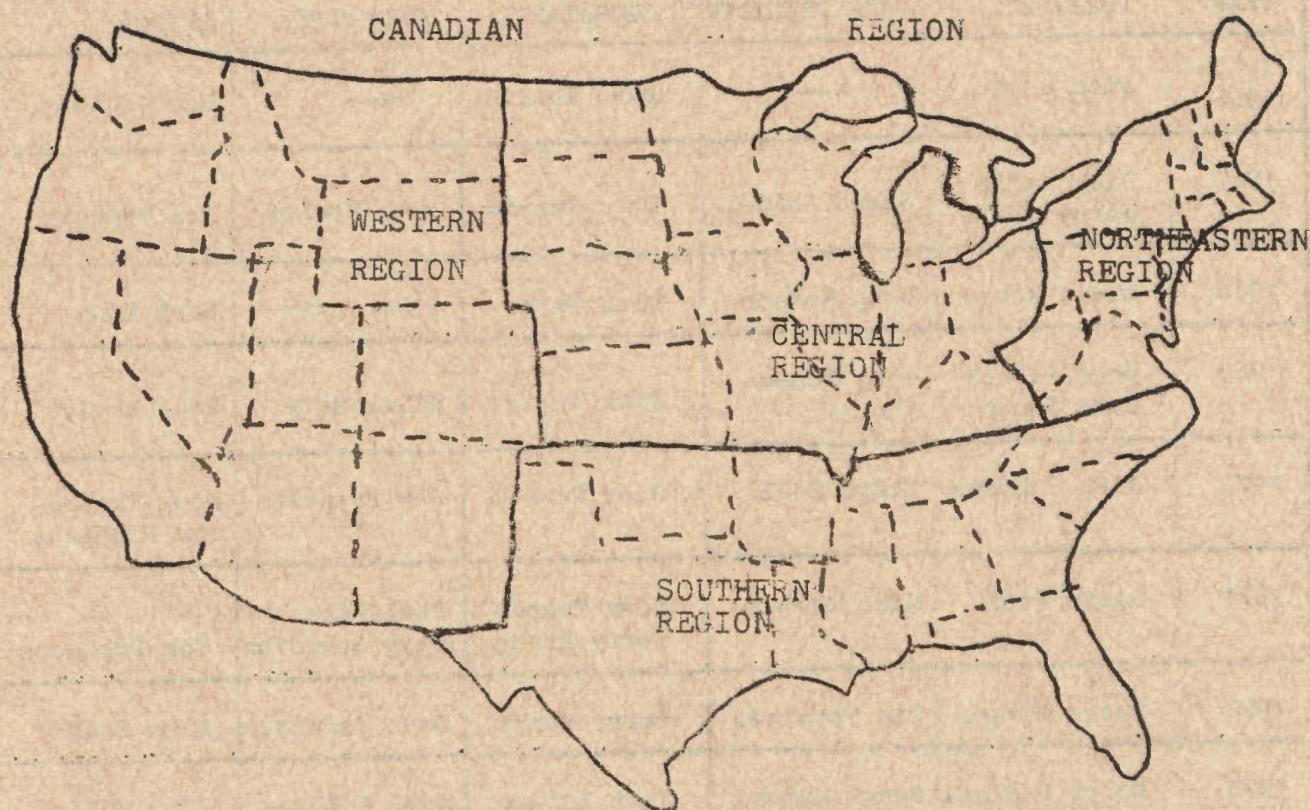
John will return one of his passes in exchange.

One of the features of the Teen Association of Model Railroading has been its regional structure. The regions were first organized around 1966 and their boundaries changed very little until Mark Soloman, then TAMR President, announced the consolidation of some regions and the division of one to make them more viable in 1975. Then in 1978, the regional structure was again changed when the former Allegheny and New England Regions agreed to merge to form the Northeastern Region. The TAMR now has a total of six regions: Canadian, Central, International (not pictured), Northeastern, Southern and Western. Many of them are active and produce their own newsletters for region members. TAMR members are encouraged to join their own region and any others they are interested in as a region membership will really increase your benefits in the association. Besides receiving the region's newsletter, many regions also sponsor meets, conventions and railfanning trips for their members as well. Below appears a capsule summary of each region and who to write for further information about joining.

CANADIAN: This region was finally re-organized this year after a long period of inactivity dating back to 1972. Currently the region has no newsletter or dues structure, but check the HOTBOX as to the latest developments as there are rumors of a newsletter in the near future. CENTRAL: After a four year rest, the region was revived in the later part of 1978. The regional newsletter is the WAYFREIGHT and it is issued six times a year. Annual regional dues are \$3.00.
